In 2018 he managed the Young Leaders Programme of the European Development Days, Europe's leading forum on international partnerships convened every year by the European Commission.



That same year he managed his first political campaign for a leading Italian parliamentary candidate and then left Brussels to join his team, working as a parliamentary assistant and political advisor. In 2021, he left Rome and joined the EU Government Affairs team of Italian energy company ENI in Brussels.

During his studies he spent an Erasmus semester in Germany and a semester exchange at an American university in Bologna. As a youth activist he managed and participated to different activities throughout the years, allowing him to gain several experiences abroad and participate to high level events such as the 2015 Paris Climate Conference (COP21), and 5th African Union - EU 2017 Summit in Abidjan.
